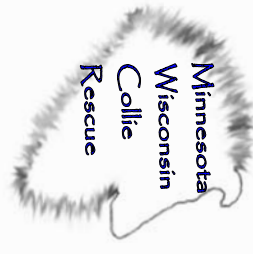


Donate something we need! Check our website or contact us for a current list of needed supplies.

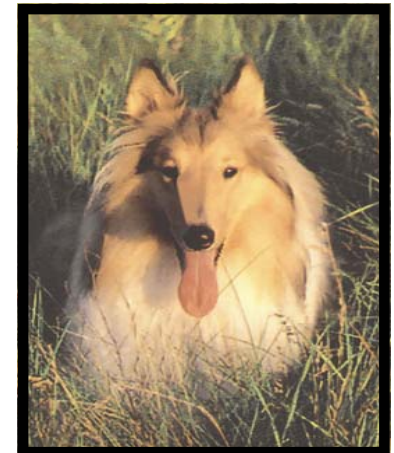

MWCR Process

Minnesota Wisconsin Collie Rescue is a non-profit organization made up of volunteers who are dedicated to the safety and welfare of rough and smooth Collies.

Animal shelters, humane societies, animal control, and private citizens in Minnesota and Wisconsin use our services. When a member of our group is contacted about a Collie that needs a home, we make arrangements to acquire the Collie - based on available foster homes.

If all medical work has not been completed, we take the Collie to a veterinarian for a health evaluation, any necessary treatment and to be updated with current vaccinations for rabies and communicable diseases. All MWCR Collies will be neutered or spayed prior to adoption.

Next, each rescued Collie is bathed and groomed if needed and placed in a foster home to receive care until we find a match with an adoptive home. The foster caregivers treat each dog as a family member. The Collie is assessed for temperament and personality as well as compatibility with other pets and children when possible. Then, a photograph and brief biography is placed on our web site so that prospective adopters know which Collies are available for adoption. On occasion, a Collie will be adopted to an approved waiting family before being placed on the web site.

When interested adopters contact us, they must complete an Adoption Questionnaire. The adopter must have an appropriate fenced or Exercise area, know something about the responsibilities of dog ownership, allow the Collie to have indoor privileges and agree to reference checks and a home check visit. This process can take anywhere from several weeks to a month or two. When approved, a suitable match is made and the adoption is completed.

MWCR Goals

- Promote neutering of all pets.
- Promote responsible dog ownership of all breeds.
- Share information on the Collie breed.
- Educate the public on responsible Collie ownership and care.
- Promote the welfare of Collies.
- Advocate responsible Collie breeding practices by reputable breeders.
- Make a forever match between Collie and new family.
